

Student Behaviour Management Policy

AIM

We believe in the importance of students learning to manage their own behaviour. Therefore we aim to promote an understanding of socially acceptable behaviour.

PRINCIPLES

- Teachers have a right to teach and students a right to learn.
- Everyone has the responsibility to respect the rights of others.
- Students have the power to change their behaviour.
- All teachers have a shared responsibility for the management of student behaviour at Penola High School.
- We use restorative practices.
- Student behaviour management and the Code of Conduct will be based on school values:

RESPECT

Treat ourselves, each other, and our environment with care

TOLERANCE

Accept individual differences

INTEGRITY

Do what is right, not what is easy

COMMITMENT

Strive to achieve our goals

HEALTHY LIFESTYLE

Maintain an active mind and body

Behaviour Management Plan



- Guidelines, school values, code of conduct and expectations restated
- Direct request to refocus and change behaviour, or a consequence will follow if behaviour continues
- Appropriate/relevant consequence applied, such as buddy/ suspension/ internal suspension
- Higher level consequence applied
- Family notified

Part of the process may be omitted if needed, based on the severity of the behaviour. Continued referrals for behaviours may lead to further actions to support the student in changing their behaviour.
